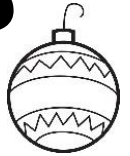

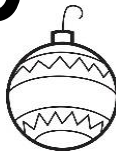

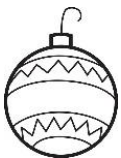

Can you collect 6 different natural items?

Find 4 leaves. Can you identify which tree they have fallen from?

Can you find 5 sticks and arrange them to form a star?

Go on a Winter walk. What signs from nature tell you that it's Winter?

Go on a Winter walk. Can you help your local environment by tidying any litter you find into a bin?

Go on a Winter walk at dusk. Can you spot any nocturnal species emerging?

Can you fill a bird-feeder with seeds to feed the birds during Winter?

Can you count how many deciduous trees there are on your street?

Can you make a weather chart to record the weather for one week?

Can you build a mini-house for a Winter Elf using natural materials?

Can you count how many evergreen trees there are on your street?

Which tree on your street do you think is the oldest and why?

How many things can you find outside beginning with S?

Can you walk around your block & count how many Christmas trees you can see?

Go outside for 5 minutes. Can you make a list of all the different sounds you can hear?

Can you find a Holly bush/ tree outside? Do all the leaves have the same number of prickles?

Can you build a Winter home for a mini-beast? Which mini-beast did you choose?

Can you collect 11 leaves and order them in different ways? (e.g. size/ shade)

Collect a pile of sticks. How many different shapes can you make with them?

Can you collect 6 different shaped leaves?

Freeze some natural materials in water. Once frozen, hang outside & time how long they take to melt.

Can you fill an old dish with water to make a Winter bird bath?

Can you hide a teddy in your garden and ask a friend/ parent to find it?

Can you build an outside obstacle course in your garden?
